The software will use a combination of peer-reviewed studies, data and mathematical models. Protein Industries Canada is amping up its investment into artificial intelligence technology by increasing focus on novel AI that will accelerate the commercialization of new plant-based ingredients and food, helping make Canada's plant-based food sector more efficient and sustainable. This newest call for industry-led projects is focused on those that utilize AI to advance the development of the country's plant-based food and ingredients.
