I am writing with a progress update on Manitoba's Protein Advantage (MPA) Strategy.

PROJECT ASPIRE UPDATES

Manitoba Agriculture and the Manitoba Protein Consortium hosted the first Animal Protein Summit, with 17 speakers from across North America and 150 stakeholders from industry, academia, non-governmental organizations, and government. The Summit highlighted opportunities for advancing sustainability and circularity across the protein sector. Agriculture Minister Derek Johnson announced a \$0.62M investment through the Canadian Agricultural Partnership to the Canadian Manufacturers and Exporters (CME) to implement the MPA Strategy through Project ASPIRE.
