I am writing with a progress update on Manitoba's Protein Advantage (MPA) Strategy.

2023 Manitoba Sustainble Protein Resaearch Symposium

A big thank you to everyone who was able to join us at the 2023 Manitoba Sustainable Protein Research Symposium! Your presence made it a successful and enriching event. With over 170 participants from industry, government, and academia from across the prairies and beyond, we furthered our research agenda to promote sustainable protein in Manitoba. We are looking forward to future collaborations.

At the symposium, Agriculture Minister Derek Johnson announced that Canada and Manitoba are investing another \$5.11 million from the new Sustainable Canadian Agricultural Partnership through March 2028 to support the work of ProteinMB. This funding is on top of the \$620,000 from the Canadian Agricultural Partnership dedicated to the initial work to establish ProteinMB. The new funds will continue to support ProteinMB's work: an industry-led Sustainable Protein Hub housed within the Canadian Manufacturers and Exporters. New Program to Help Canada's Plant-Based Sector Prepare to Utilize Artificial Intelligence

The plant-based sector in Canada is working towards sustainability and increased efficiencies with artificial intelligence technology. To harness this potential, companies must understand what makes an effective AI solution including how to build and utilize effective data pools. In partnership with Amii (the Alberta Machine Intelligence Institute), Protein Industries Canada is launching the Data Readiness Improvement Program (DRIP). Canada and Manitoba Invest \$2 Million to Enhance Capacity of Rural Veterinary Services Districts

The governments of Canada and Manitoba are investing \$2 million through the new Sustainable Canadian Agricultural Partnership to enhance the capacity of rural veterinary services districts throughout Manitoba. Each district will be eligible to receive up to \$75,000 toward the purchase of large-animal veterinary equipment, allowing them to offer expanded services in their district.
