Agricultural and Agri-Food Minister Marie-Claude Bibeau announced an investment of \$13M to enhance the Youth Employment and Skills Program (YESP) and support over 1200 jobs for youth. For agricultural employers hiring Canadian youth, the YESP Program offers 50% wage support up to \$14,000.
