Manitoba Pork has secured \$944,340 in funding from Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada's African Swine Fever Industry Preparedness Program to fortify its fight against African swine fever (ASF). This funding will support critical initiatives like the Squeal on Pigs Manitoba program, communication with small-scale pork producers, and an ASF response plan.
